Blast from the Past By David J. Price

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation

Here is an advertisement from the June 1976 issue of Radio Control Modeler for the Heath Pack-17 plug-in modules. Remember the days of the radio with a single 72 MHz radio frequency and having to wait to fly because someone else was on your frequency? With the Heath Pack-17 plug-in modules you could switch to a different frequency just by changing the module. With frequency hopping spread spectrum 2.4GHz radios, the days of these modules are long gone (thank goodness – I hated having to wait for my frequency to be open). Yes, 72 MHz narrow band RC systems are still legal to use (as well as 27 MHz, 50 MHz, 53 MHz, and 75 MHz).

I am sure all of you have heard of Joe Nall Triple Tree Aerodome. The 42nd Anniversary of the event was May 10 -17, so it will have just ended by the time you read this article. The facility is over 400 acres with 100 motor home campsites and a 7000-foot grass runway for full scale aircraft. I went with Mickey B, Jessie Harris, Martin Weinstock. The event goes on for little more than a week, we went down on the first Saturday and stayed till Tuesday which is the day we drove home. The quality of some of the aircraft is outstanding and is some of the best you will see anywhere. If your curious about this event you can go down a YouTube rabbit hole and check out what you might see if you were to go one day.
